

June Morning Watch



Have you ever tried to describe God? King David tried it, and here is one of the things he wrote: *"Since you are my rock and my fortress, for the sake of Your name lead and guide me."* (Psalm 31:3) In order to understand what he meant - that God who is a Spirit can be our solid rock - it is important that we know what the Word of God says about Him. He is described as a rock in many places and we will be looking at them this month.

Each day do the following:

1. Begin with prayer.
2. Read the passage looking for the reference(s) to the Rock.
3. Make a list of the characteristics that are used to describe the Rock.
4. Look for anything that you are told to do, or that the writer says they do, especially in relation to the Rock.
5. How can/should your life be different because of your relationship with the "Rock"?
6. What problems or trials do you need to turn over to the "Rock"?
7. End in prayer. Stand on the "Solid Rock" and claim all that He is. Then give Him all your problems and let Him handle them.

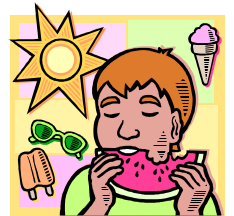
